This divide is now the single most potent force keeping Christianity safely domesticated in the private sphere, stripping it of power to challenge and redeem the broader culture. Which is exactly what secularists want.

With razor-sharp analysis, Pearcey exposes the way this deadly new definition of truth functions as a gatekeeper to rule Christian principles out of bounds in the public arena. She equips readers to detect the strategies that secularists use—and then to overcome them for personal and social renewal. In this great refusal to secularism, *Total Truth* shows readers how to unify their lives and recover spiritual power.

With examples from the struggles and successes of real people, past and present, Pearcey takes readers on a thought-provoking, often surprising journey of liberation. In the process, she uncovers the destructive impact of the Darwinian worldview, reveals unexpected new angles on feminism, revives Francis Schaeffer’s remarkably effective method of apologetics, and exposes the surprising relation of New Age spirituality to Islam.

Nancy R. Pearcey is the Francis A. Schaeffer Scholar at the World Journalism Institute, where she teaches a worldview curriculum based on *Total Truth: Liberating Christianity from Its Cultural Captivity*. After studying under Schaeffer at L’Abri Fellowship in Switzerland in the early 1970s, Pearcey earned an M.A. from Covenant Theological Seminary, followed by graduate work in the history of philosophy at the Institute for Christian Studies in Toronto. She has been writing on Christian worldview, especially its relation to science, since 1977. In 1991 she became the founding editor of “BreakPoint,” a national radio commentary program, and served as executive editor for nearly nine years. Her current positions include Visiting Scholar at Biola University’s Torrey Honors Institute and Senior Fellow at the Discovery Institute. Pearcey’s articles have appeared in periodicals such as *First Things*, *The Washington Times*, *Human Events*, *The Regent University Law Review*, and *Christianity Today*. She has authored or contributed to several works, including Crossway’s *The Soul of Science* and the bestselling, ECPA Gold Medallion-winning *How Now Shall We Live?*
